

Pre Bid Clarifications for Tender for Health Promotion Centre

Sl No	Query	Clarification
1	Should the tender document be submitted online or physical?	The physical tender document should be submitted so as to reach the Centre well before the due submission time.
2	Value of Solvency Certificate	The solvency certificate should be for a minimum of Rs. 14 Lakhs, from nationalised / scheduled banks. The solvency certificate should not be dated more than 6 months. In case an agency is unable to submit the solvency certificate for the full amount along with the technical bid, an undertaking from their banker should be submitted.
3	Is it compulsory to quote for bio-medical waste?	The bidders should quote for all the requirements as per the financial bid. The centre is currently tied up with Prajwal BMW Management Systems (A Unit of VV incin Solutions Private Limited) for the collection of covid 19 medical / biomedical waste.
4	Qualification of Nursing staff	The minimum qualification of nurses to be deployed shall be as per the tender document. Minimum BSc/ MSc – Nursing with 5 years' experience
